## Introduction

Web Trader's widgets appear on the right-hand side of the platform and are always there no matter what tab you are on. If you don't want them taking up space, you can always collapse them by clicking .

## Add Widgets

The goal behind "Add Widget" button is to make sure there is a place where you could always have easy access to all trading tools. By scrolling the drop-down menu of "Add Widget", click on the picked widget and it will be automatically added to the tab menu.



-	Cash	<p>Value is changed by each trade.</p> <p>Buy (long and close short): cash = cash - position current market value.</p> <p>Sell (short and close long): cash = cash + position current market value</p> <p><b>Q:</b> Why we can't show it on UI?</p> <p><b>A:</b> Because it can be negative. (Example: Account balance is \$1000. Margin rate: 20%. Trader opens new long position which is \$2000. Cash = -\$1000)</p>
Day Trades	DayTrades	<p>Amount of day trades. Check the <a href="#">FINRA explanation</a> about what day trades are.</p> <p>Contains number of day trades during last 5 bussines days (including current).</p>
Pending Cash	-	<p>It is the amount of money that is reserved to provide a transaction. This reserve is withheld from Cash when an order is placed.</p>
Equity Total	-	<p>Means your available money plus positions money if you will close it.</p> <p><b>Equity = Cash + Long Stocks - Short Stocks.</b> This formula provides Equity invariability when position is opened or closed.</p>
Long Stocks	-	<p>Shows the sum of PCMV* of long positions. When a price of any long position security changes, Long Stocks also changes.</p>
Short Stocks	-	<p>Shows the sum of PCMV* of short positions. When a price of any short position security changes, Short Stocks also changes .</p>
Long Options	-	<p>Shows the sum of PCMV* of long positions. When a price of any long position security changes, Long Options also changes.</p>
Short Options	-	<p>Shows the sum of PCMV* of short positions. When a price of any short position security changes, Short Options also changes .</p>
Maintenance Margin	-	<p>The minimum amount of equity that must be maintained in a margin account.</p>
Option Maintenance Margin	-	<p>The minimum amount of equity that must be maintained in a margin account for options securities</p>
Excess	-	<p>Amount of money available for withdraw or to open new positions.</p> <p><b>Excess = Equity - TMMR - Pending Cash - Uncleared Cash</b>, where TMMR - Total Maintenance Margin Requirement - the sum of margin requirements for all positions per account</p> <p>TMMR = Sum of all positions MMR</p> <p>for Cash Accounts <b>Excess = Cash - Pending Cash - Uncleared Cash - Unsettled Cash</b></p>

Stock Buying Power	-	<p>Amount of money that you are available to buy stocks</p> <p><b>Stock Buying Power = Equity - (MR% * CMV)</b>, where MR% - margin requirement; CMV - current market value</p> <p><u>Case: Assume you have a margin account with a debit balance of \$20,000, a current market value of \$50,000 and a margin requirement of 50 percent. Your account equity is \$30,000, which is calculated using the formula <math>\\$50,000 - \\$20,000 = \\$30,000</math>.</u></p> <p><u>The account's stock buying power is \$5,000, which is calculated using the formula <math>\\$30,000 - (0.5 * \\$50,000) = \\$5,000</math>. In this case, you have \$5,000 in buying power that you can use to purchase new stock.</u></p>
Option Buying Power	-	<p>Amount of money that you are available to buy options.</p> <p><b>Option Buying Power = Excess * OMR</b>, where OMR - Option Margin Rate and equals 1</p>
Day Open Profit/Loss	-	Amount of money (Unrealized Profit/Loss) at the trading session opening.
Day Close Profit/Loss	-	Amount of money (Realized Profit/Loss) for previous trading session.
Net Liquidation Value	-	<p>Current value of your account</p> <p><b>Net Liquidation Value = Long Stocks + Long Options - Short Stocks - Short Options</b></p>
Pending Orders Count	-	Amount of orders with status "New" or "Partially Filled".
Uncleared Cash	-	Amount of uncleared funds.
Unsettled Cash	-	Amount of unsettled funds.
Day Trader Buying Power	-	Amount of available funds for day trader account.
Cash Balance	-	

**\*Position Current Market Value** - as for cash account this parameter shows the current cost of the position. PCMV changes when underlying security price changes.

**\*\*Base** - a technical parameter that shows the balance between the initial cost of long positions and initial costs of short positions + account own money. This value may be negative. It means that the initial cost of long positions > initial costs of short positions + account own money. This parameter is useless for an account holder. But it uses by the trading system to calculate Equity.

Position's Price = Last Price \* Quantity

1. Open Option Ticket, choose parameters you need (action, quantity, strike, etc.). Note that OCO orders let you to cancel automatically one order when the other order(-s) will be executed. So you should use OCO order if you want to open position with limit orders.
